As of today, September 10, the numbers of positive Covid 19 cases in Kosciusko County are up. This means, that the 8 a.m. Celebration of Holy Eucharist will be held inside. Attendance guidelines are: 10 individuals or 15 with five individuals and 5 couples may attend in the sanctuary. We have set up 35 chairs that are social distanced in groups of 1, 2, 3, or 4 to allow seating for individuals as well as families. The limit for Rose Hall for seating while there is an increase in positive Covid cases is the same as the sanctuary, 10 individuals or 15 with five individuals and 5 couples may attend.
