Items needed for the AWL are: Dog/Cat dried food, wet food, dog leashes, collars, Dog/Cat toys, Dog/Cat treat (No raw hides or Milk Bone brand), Stainless steel or ceramic bowls, paper towels, non-clumping cat litter, litter pans, Flea/tick preventative (no collars), blankets, towels (no holes), flat sheets, disinfectant wipes, pet wipes, air freshener, disinfectant spray (no Lysol), liquid laundry soap, hand soap and sanitizer, bleach, toilet paper, Kleenex, heartworm preventative, brooms and brushes.
